

#### **PREFACE**


If you want to share your life with a believer, you must be aligned with his/her Father. You should therefore first work on yourself before expecting the change elsewhere!

### CORNERSTONE OF SCRIPTURAL SALVATION - I John 1:5-10

- □ Our salvation is based on God's promise to save and cleanse.
- ☐ To be saved, you must turn away from your sins and believe on Jesus as Saviour.
- □ Salvation produces a changed life: you become God's child (II Corinthians 5:17).
- □ When God saves you, He saves you unto good works (Ephesians 2:10).

#### **COMMITMENT TO SACRIFICIAL SERVICE – Romans 12:1**

- □ Service is an expression of our love for God (Mark 12:28-31).
- □ It is the visible manifestation of true consecration (Romans 12:1,2,11).
- ☐ Your service should be according to God's specification (Romans 12:4-8).
- ☐ The aim must be to glorify God (Romans 15:5,6).





# CULTIVATION OF SOCIAL SKILLS (1) – Proverbs 18:24

The lifestyle you develop in the house of God actually follows you into your marriage. Therefore, work on biblical social skills, and your vital relationship will be transformed!

- ☐ Bearing burdens Galatians 6:2,5:
  - Look beyond personal gain or interest.
  - Strive to contribute something positive to another.
  - Care: let others' needs draw your practical action!
  - Take responsibility and challenge others to do so too.

- ☐ Communication with courtesy
  - I Peter 3:8:
    - Let there be no anger, clamour or evil speaking.
    - Make no negative assumptions: "Prove all things...".
    - Desist from murmuring: find room to air your views.

## CULTIVATION OF SOCIAL SKILLS (2) – I Corinthians 10:31-33

- ☐ Obedience and oneness (Hebrews 13:1,17):
  - There should be no segregation (male-female, rich-poor, old-young, nationality-tribe, etc.)
  - Submit yourself to leadership: this is practical submission to the Lord.

- □ Resolution with respect (Colossians 3:12-14):
  - Offences are bound to occur!
  - Avoid any root of bitterness: don't bottle up!
  - Follow Jesus' protocol (Matthew 18:15-17).
  - Never take a believer to court! (I Corinthians 6:1-7).

The focus of a true believer is a life without offence or hindrance to others; rather, he inspires, helps and comforts. True Christianity focuses on a good report. What then is a better preparation for marital bliss than a life taught by God to be socially skilful!
