



RESTORING THE DEPARTED GLORY


- Haggai 2:3,8,9

What do we see in a vibrant Christian?

- ■Inner peace: Isa 32:17
- ■Tenderness of heart: 1 Sam 24:4-6
- Devotional prayer: Acts 9:11
- Love for fellowship: Acts 2:46,47
- Heavenly passion: Heb 10:34
- Fervent & joyful service: Rom 12:11-13
- Watchfulness & sobriety: 1 Thes 5:5-8
- Gratitude: Acts 5:41,42

When these things are lost, the believer is reduced to an empty shell: mere professor.






THE POINTERS OF BESETTING, VICIOUS COLDNESS

There are pointers that signify spiritual defect and an urgent need for recovery:

- A wearisome altar: 1 Sam 14:35; 28:4-6
- Love of 'officiating': Mat 23:5-7
- External, earthly focus: Rev 3:17
- Leaking tongue / loose lips: Pro 25:28
- Irritability, harshness, strife...: Pro 12:18
- Distaste of humble service: Neh 3:5
- Scorning of leadership: Num 12:1-3

When you see any of these or similar traits, the need for restoration is evident!






THE PRICE OF BLESSED, VIGOROUS COMEBACK
