PREPARATION FOR THE QUIET TIME

Mark 1:35; Genesis 19:27; Psa 5:3; Eph 6;10,11.

- Endeavour to have steady communion with God early in the morning (or times when the mind is still very flesh and unoccupied).
- Maintain such a time and nothing should be allowed to interfere with it.
- Have with you
 - A good (KJV) Bible (with concordance)
 - An aid to daily Bible Study,
 - A notebook and a pen

PLAN OF THE QUIET TIME


Ps 1:1-3; 5:3; 139:23, 24.

 - There may be a task to perform.

- Commentaries (Matthew Henry, Pulpit)
- Historical books, e.g. Josephus, other church history books etc

GOOD METHODS FOR EFFECTIVE STUDY

- **Doctrine:** The Godhead (Trinity) Salvation and Sanctification and holy living, Holy Ghost Baptism, marriage, eschatology, etc
- Topical study: Faith, grace, prayer & fasting, fruit of the Spirit Worship, tithe & offering, etc.
- Book study: Take a book (e.g. John), examine it from all angles: dispensation, geography, devotional, etc.
- Chapter study/Paragraph/verse study: E.g. Luke 15; Hebrews 11, etc
- Character study: Pick up an individual; Search the scriptures on his life, works, ministry, virtues, errors, God's dealing, etc
