

DEEPER CHRISTIAN LIFE MINISTRY, THE NETHERLANDS

PROGRAMMES IN 2025

The theme of Year 2025 was **“One Family”**. The vision for the year was to strengthen the Church as a united family, with emphasis on unity and togetherness as one body in Christ. The Church focused on reaching out to others, discipling new believers, and growing together as one Church family under the leadership of Jesus Christ, sharing one faith, feeding on the Word of God, and pursuing a common heavenly focus.

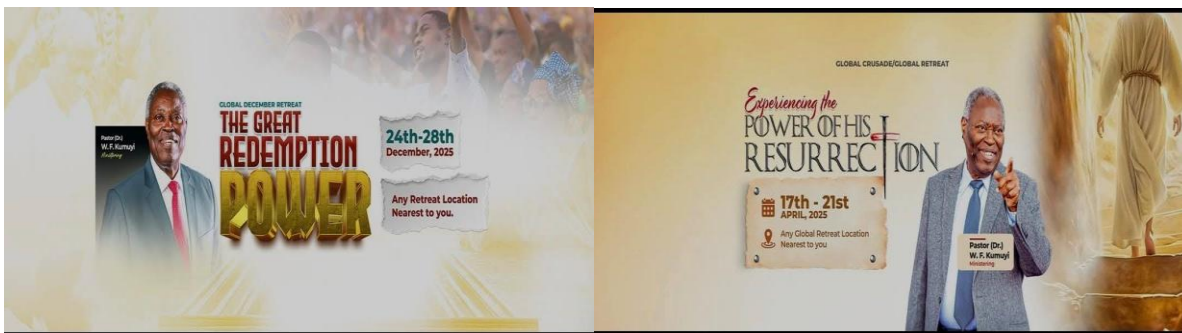
To realise this vision, several programmes were organised throughout 2025, delivered either fully online or in a hybrid format. Some of these are highlighted below:

A. NATIONAL PROGRAMMES

These are programmes that all churches in The Netherlands participated in at the same time together or separately at the various regions. These were

1. Easter Retreat: The annual Easter retreat - GCK was held from 17 -21 April 2025, with the theme “Experiencing the power of His resurrection”. This year’s retreat was combined with the Global Crusade with Kumuyi (GCK). The focus was on experiencing the Power of Christ. Topics covered include “Crucified with Christ”, “Without holiness of heart, no heaven”, “Priority of daily fellowship with God”, “Waiting for His Resurrection”, “Holy Communion”, “Risen with Christ”, “Faithfulness to God in all things”, “Encouragement in Christian service”, “Rising by grace and reigning in glory”, among others.

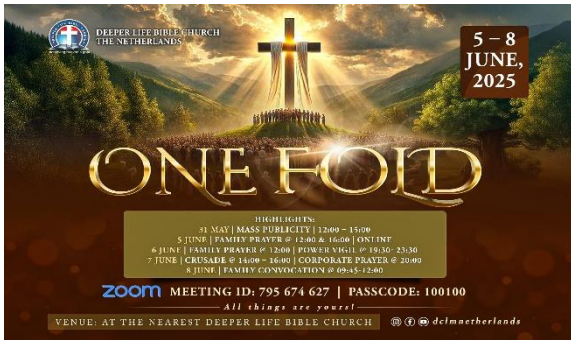
2. December Retreat: The December retreat- GCK was held from 25-28 December 2025. The theme was “The Great Redemption Power”. The programme featured local and global sessions with opportunities for participants to listen to the word of God, pray, worship and fellowship together. Topics covered included “The uniqueness of Jesus”, “Victory over temptations and trials”, “Our sevenfold privilege in Christ”, “Practical love in soul-winning”, “The promise of the Father for sanctified believers”, “The healing stripes of Jesus”, “Perfecting the saints and converts with eternity in view”, “Looking unto Jesus”, among others.



3. National Family Convocation: Quarterly Family Convocation Services were held throughout the year. These services were preceded by focused spiritual activities, including prayer and fasting programs, power vigils, and regional outreaches, all aligned with the central vision of the year. The quarterly themes are:

- Q1: One Faith
- Q2: One Fold
- Q3: One Food
- Q4: One Focus

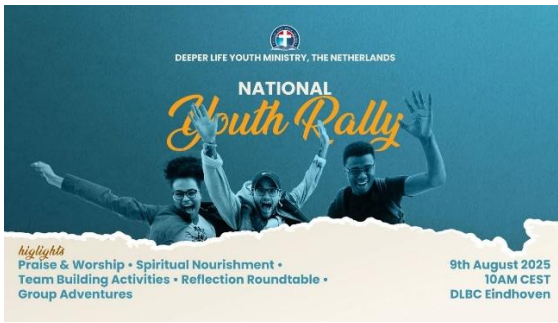


4. National Children Program: The children's programme was held across different regions. The children were taught the Word of God, obedience to their parents, and how to live a good life that pleases God. The programme also included craft activities and practical life lessons such as personal care and hygiene.

5. National Women's Ministry: The ministry organized an engaging Cake Baking Workshop across the regions, giving participants practical culinary skills along with opportunities for creativity and fellowship. In addition, outreach activities continued with a visit to a local refugee camp, where relief materials were distributed to support vulnerable communities.



6. National Youth Rally: The event was designed to inspire, connect, and empower young people by providing a platform for spiritual growth, fellowship, and personal development. It primarily catered to youth seeking meaningful engagement, spiritual enrichment, and opportunities for community involvement.



7. Tertiary & Young Professionals Forum (Beyond Limits): The Tertiary and Young Professionals Forum of the Netherlands successfully hosted the “Beyond Limits” event, designed to equip attendees with spiritual tools to support both personal growth and professional development. The event combined worship, mentorship, and practical guidance to create a holistic learning experience for young professionals.



8. National Choir Conference (Onwards Towards Ministerial Excellence): The conference brought together choir members from different regions for spiritual growth, training, and fellowship. Participants were equipped with teachings focused on excellence in ministry, and growth in musical and spiritual capacity. The conference strengthened unity, vision, and commitment to serving God through music ministry as the choir continues to work towards Vision 2030.



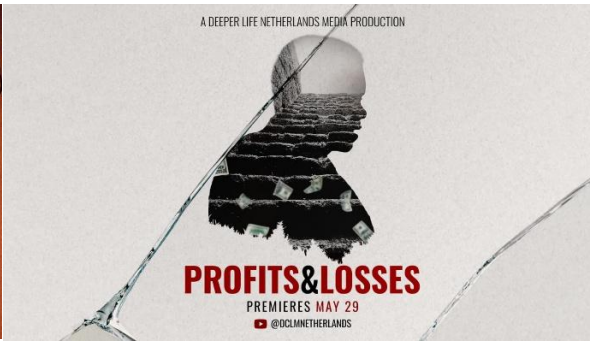
9. Love & Marriage Seminar: The seminars were highly successful in educating and inspiring both youths and adults to embrace God’s design for healthy relationships and marriage. Through interactive talks, discussions, and practical exercises, participants gained valuable tools for communication, commitment, and spiritual growth, leaving encouraged to apply these principles in their daily lives.



10. Believer's Development Program: The Believer's Development Program spanned 11 months and focused on deepening participants' understanding of God's Word. Members who completed all lessons and assignments received certificates honoring their commitment and learning.

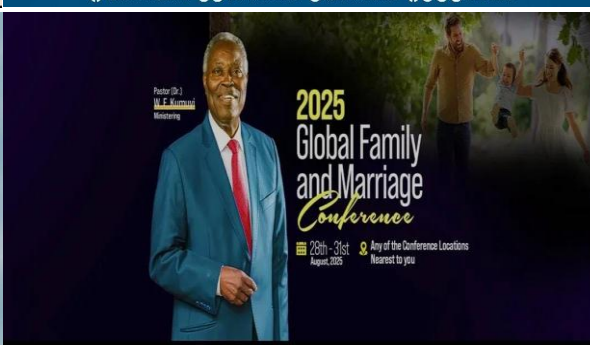


11. DCLM NL Creative Media Production: The DCLM NL Creative Media Production team produced a short, inspiring movie Profit & Losses and a powerful monologue Together in Service, both designed to motivate and uplift viewers while sharing meaningful messages aligned with the church's mission. The productions have been well received and continue to serve as a platform for spreading positive and spiritual messages. They showcased creativity, teamwork, and technical skill, and are available online for the congregation and wider audience to view.



12. Global Crusades/Conferences: The church participated (via Zoom and social media) in the monthly Global crusades and conferences organised by the headquarters church in Africa.

- February: Living Hope Through Christ, (20 -25 February 2025)
- March: The Day of His Power (27 March- 1 April 2025)
- April: Experiencing the Power of His Resurrection (17-21 April 2025)
- May: Global Workers Conference (28-31 May 2025)
- July: Christ: The source of all Possibilities (24 – 29 July 2025)
- August: Global Family and Marriage Conference (28-31 August 2025)
- November: Supernatural Cure and Cleansing Through Christ (27 November – 2 December 2025)
- December: The Great Redemption Power (25-28 December 2025)



B. REGIONAL PROGRAMMES

Beside the national programmes, the following regular meetings were held in the different church locations in Amsterdam, Eindhoven, and The Hague:

- Sunday Worship Service (weekly)

- Tuesday Bible Study (weekly)
- Friday Revival and Evangelism Training Service (weekly).

Special programmes/events were also held by local churches during the year. For example, Amsterdam region had the STORM program, Eindhoven region had the Super Sunday program filled with testimonies and Thanksgiving Day, and The Hague region had a Barbeque outreach.
